



Froniditha Care President inducted in 2019 Victorian Honour Roll

Froniditha Care's first female President, Faye Spiteri, has been inducted into the 2019 Victorian Honour Roll of Women for her work on social change.

Mrs Spiteri was nominated in the category of "change agent" which awards women who have made enduring commitments that have brought about significant and lasting change.

Receiving the honour on Friday 8 March 2019, which coincides with International Women's Day, Mrs Spiteri was singled out for her "compassion and leadership" in changing the lives of women, migrants and refugees.

"She is committed to giving voice to the most vulnerable people in Victoria," her honour read.

"As an ardent proponent of human rights and gender equity, Faye has championed the right of women to live free from violence."

Mrs Spiteri has devoted her time to Froniditha Care voluntarily, and has been a part of the organisation's Board since 2009.

She was elected as the organisation's first female President in 2018, and leads a Board composed of six females and three males.

"Women need to support other women," she said.

"We can only be brave if others believe in us, and encourage our passions and intellect. Become a mentor. It's a wonderful way to contribute and pass on your wisdom."

She is currently the Chair of InTouch's Board of Directors, and was previously a Partner at Hall & Partners and a Communications Director for Cultural Perspectives at the Clemenger Group.
