Dear resident/ family member/ representative,

As you would be aware, a COVID-19 outbreak has been identified in Greater Sydney, the Central Coast and Sydney's Northern Beaches. As a result, NSW Public Health Unit is issuing restrictive measures to residential aged care providers that must be adhered to, in order to protect our residents, staff and the broader community.

A Public Health Order issued yesterday, Sunday 20/12/2020, requests the following:

- No visitation to residential aged care providers unless by exemption
- All staff and visitors are to wear surgical masks when on the premises of a residential aged care facility.

FronDitha Care will therefore not be permitting visitation to the HIPPOCRATES residential care home in Mayfield. All visits are effectively cancelled. If you require an exemption, please contact MRC Garrison Brassington on (02) 4016 4160 or 0417 838 726.

The following applies until 23/12/2020 11:59pm. We will await further instruction from NSW Health on 24/12/2020 regarding new measures and we will subsequently communicate these to you.

This may not be the news you were hoping to here as Australia prepares to celebrate Christmas with loved ones. We will keep you updated regarding changes to restrictions as mandated by NSW Public Health Unit and if there are further restrictions FronDitha Care implements voluntarily.

Our primary concern is our people. Their safety and health are our priority.
