**RE: Visitor Restrictions**

Yesterday morning, NSW Premier Gladys Berejiklian announced a series of restrictions for Greater Sydney, The Illawarra, Blue Mountains and the Central Coast. The restrictions came into effect from Wednesday, June 24 at 4:00 pm.

Specifically:

- Masks will be compulsory in all indoor non-residential settings, including workplace
- Organised outdoor events, visitors to households will be limited to 5 guests
- The one person per four square metre rule will be re-introduced for all indoor and outdoor settings, including weddings and funerals
- If you live or work in the **City of Sydney, Waverley, Randwick, Canada Bay, Inner West, Bayside, and Woollahra local government areas**, you cannot travel outside metropolitan Sydney for non-essential travel.

Following the Premier's directives, you will not be permitted to enter FronDitha Care's Newcastle facility if you live and work in the aforementioned areas.
